











## **Bachelor of Technology in Quantity Surveying**

Quantity surveying has been recognized as an independent profession by a Sri Lankan parliamentary act. It enjoys a very high worldwide demand; particularly in the Middle Eastern countries. Sri Lankan quantity surveyors (SLQS) have dominated the industry with their professional integrity, efficiency and superior skills performed in the discipline.

Bachelor of Technology degree in Quantity Surveying offers by the University of Vocational Technology aims to provide practicing Quantity Surveyors employed at the middle level with diploma level qualifications, an opportunity of achieving professional advancement through acquisition of higher academic qualifications. Establishing, the three years B. Tech QS degree course in the year 2015, was a remarkable achievement of both the University of Vocational Technology and SLQS history. This very first (and the only) degree course conducted by the Sri Lankan Government for the practicing Quantity Surveyors, would add billions of much needed foreign currencies to the national GDP in the future.

#### **Techno Exhibition 2015**



student recruitment, customer satisfaction (student, employers, parents) and financial review. A training provider is expected to maintain atleast a checklist to monitor above nine processes/activities in the training delivery.

What benefits a training provider could anticipate by establishing and maintaining the revised QMS in their training centres.

- All types of customers of a training institute viz. students' (immediate customer), parents', industry' (employer) satisfaction through feedback are able to measure and take corrective/preventive actions
- Less documentation for the institute; only six procedures with nine checklists to implement
- Continuous improvement through conducting data

- analysis, internal auditing, corrective/preventive actions
- Financial stability of the institute or the cost per student is measured/computed to visualize sustainability of the operations or return on committed value of the institute
- More emphasis on occupational Health & Safety through training environment/infrastructure maintenance
- Greater number of staff involvement in the maintenance of QMS in the institute

A training institute which could establish and maintain revised QMS could achieve its projected targets and ensure competitive advantage over the others.

## REVISED QUALITY MANAGEMENT SYSTEM OF TVET AND ITS BENEFITS FOR TRAINING PROVIDERS



uality Management System (QMS) is the yardstick to measure the quality of services rendered by any service provider. Similarly an effective QMS is a vital pillar for a training institution to maintain its registration and accreditation of courses stipulated by the TVEC to award NVQ. This QMS provides a "Process Approach" instead of final quality of delivered service, according to the base of ISO 9001:2008 and SLS IWA 2: 2007. Main objective of the revised QMS is to establish, document, implement, continually improve and maintain a user friendly assured Quality of training in

training centres. This facilitates training providers to ensure their quality and to produce competent craftsmen / technicians who fulfil the current needs of industry.

The other purpose of introducing this requirement is to ensure effective client relations, sound financial planning and control, responsive systems operations and reliable record keeping & document management.

Revised QMS lies with SIX by NINE matrix, which is to imply six mandatory procedures specified in the ISO 9001 standards while nine processes/activities of education & training specified in the IWA2.

Six procedures derived in the QMS are,

 Proper maintenance of documents at the training centre (document control)

- 2. Maintenance of records at the training centre (records control)
- 3. Review & Verification of QMS established at the training centre (internal audits, management review)
- 4. Deficiencies identified and attended to at the training centre (control of non-conformities)
- 5. Deviations corrected and attended to while monitoring the system (corrective action)
- 6. Further improvements of the QMS, training centre processes

The other purpose of introducing this requirement is to ensure effective client relations, sound financial planning and control, responsive systems operations and reliable record keeping & document management.

These six procedures will play the role of monitoring of key activities/processes of a training provider. The nine processes/activities are academic staff concerns (vital affairs of academia), training equipment maintenance & material purchases, training environment/infrastructure maintenance, use of appropriate NCSs & curricular/other training documents, final & continuous assessments/related processes, training delivery process,
